

Port Washington School District to Host Bond Fair

During the meeting, the details of the proposed scope of work will be presented along with the financial facts. Residents will also have an opportunity to have their questions answered.

The school district is at a crossroads and one of only a few on Long Island showing an upward trend in enrollment. The district's facilities are aging and were never designed to support the needs of today's students, the more rigorous and competitive curriculum, future enrollment projections and the Board of Education and administration's educational vision for the future.
