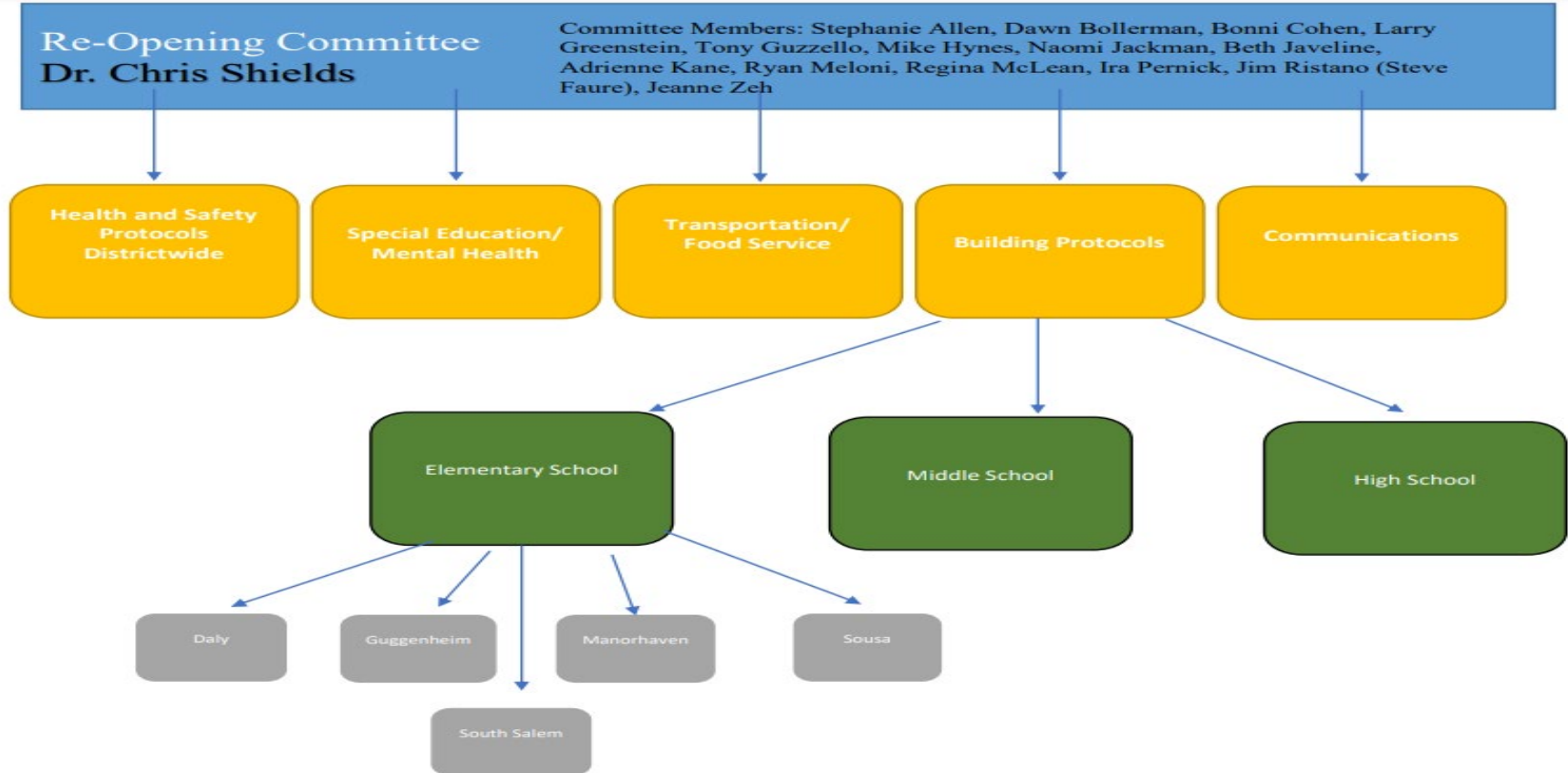




Preparing for September 2021

Reopening Committee 2020-2021



Phases of Learning & Guidance from NYSDOH & NYSED

Elementary

- Phased in approach with all elementary students being full in person by October 1st
- Desk shields were in place
- Students spaced at 3 feet apart in class, 6 feet for lunch and 12 feet for chorus and wind instruments
- One to one technology initiative implemented for students and staff

Secondary


- Students began the year with hybrid instruction at both Weber and Schreiber
 - Students spaced at 6 feet apart
- Return to full in person instruction April 2021
 - Desk shields were in place initially
 - Students spaced at 3 feet
- One to one technology initiative implemented for students and staff

Current Guidance Documents and Issues


- March 19, 2021 CDC Guidance for K-12 Schools
 - Revised physical distancing, clarified ventilation, removed recommendation for barriers
- April 9, 2021 NYSDOH Guidance Interim Guidance for In-person Instruction at PreK to Grade 12 Schools
 - Align NYS guidance with March CDC guidance
- June 7, 2021 update to eliminate mask mandate OUTDOORS for students

Expectations for September 2021

“Normal as possible”

- In person learning for all students
 - Medically Fragile accommodations
 - Classroom layout and materials
 - Masks indoors
 - Still at 6 feet: Lunch, Chorus, Wind Instruments
 - Isolation Rooms
 - Vaccination status

Action Steps

- Staffing our schools for full return of students
 - Returning classroom furniture from storage
 - Ask the Governor and NYSDOH to be clear with requirements early
 - Fine tune our protocols based on any new guidance
