

VOTER REGISTRATION POLICY

Can I vote on May 21, 2019?

To vote, you must be a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age or older, a resident of the school district for at least 30 days before the vote and be registered voter.

Do I have to register to vote?

Individuals who have not previously voted or who have not voted in either a general election or a school board election within the last four years need to register.

What if I am not sure if I am registered or if I meet the criteria to register?

You can call 767-5012. The school district has information provided by the Board of Elections in Mineola as well as our own voter records and will be able to confirm your status.

Can I register in Port Washington?

Personal Registration will be held at the Administration Building, 100 Campus Drive, from Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. You must register by May 16, in order to be eligible to vote on May 21.

What if those times are not convenient?

You can register at the Board of Elections at 240 Old Country Road, Mineola, NY 11501 and received no less than 25 days before the date of the vote.

Is there any other way to register?

Go to the website www.elections.state.ny.us and print out the registration form. This form must be mailed to the Board of Elections at 240 Old Country Road, Mineola, NY 11501 and received no less than 25 days before the date of the vote.

What do I need to bring to register?

Please bring photo identification or an acceptable alternative. A New York State driver's license is ideal.

What about absentee voting?

If you are unavoidably absent from Nassau County on Election Day or unable to appear at the polls due to illness or disability, Absentee Ballot Applications are available at the Administration Building at 100 Campus Drive or by calling 767-5012. Upon completion, applications must be mailed to or returned to the District Clerk, Administration Building, 100 Campus Drive, Port Washington, NY 11050. Upon receipt of the application, a ballot will be provided to the absentee voter to complete. The application must be received by the district clerk at least seven days before the vote if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or no later than the day before the vote if the ballot is to be issued to the voter in person.

Can I both register and vote on May 21?

No – no one can register to vote and cast a ballot on same day, however, you may register to vote on May 21 in order to be eligible to vote in future School District Elections.
