

**The School Budget Vote and Election
Tuesday, May 21 from 6 AM – 10 PM
Weber Middle School**

ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

YOU MUST BE REGISTERED BY MAY 16 TO VOTE IN THIS SCHOOL ELECTION.

Note: You must register to vote if you are a new resident or have not voted in the last four years.

There are two ways to register for the school election:

1. **Register with the Nassau County Board of Elections.** (You will be eligible to vote in all school, local, state and federal elections.)
 - Download it from the Nassau County Board of Elections website:

 - Complete the form, sign it, and mail it to: Nassau County Board of Elections, 240 Old Country Road (5th fl.), Mineola, NY 11501-4800.
 - Do this now. You must mail or deliver your form as soon as possible and no later than May 1.
2. **Register in person with the school district by May 16 by going in person to:**

Monday to Friday from 9 AM – 3 PM**

Please bring a photo ID or an acceptable alternative. A New York State driver's license is ideal.

Apply for an absentee ballot
To find out how, visit Portnet.org and click on "Procedure for Voting by Absentee Ballot & Absentee Ballot Application" (under News and Announcements)

To be eligible to register to vote, you must:

Be a U.S. citizen; be 18 years old by December 31 of the year in which you file this form (note: you must be 18 years old by the date of the election in which you want to vote); live at your present address at least 30 days before an election; not be in jail or on parole for a felony conviction; and not claim the right to vote elsewhere.
