Dear Port Washington Community,

Governor Andrew Cuomo issued an executive order extending the deadline for school districts to receive school budget vote and Board of Education election absentee ballots. All voting this year is by absentee ballot only. The new regulations permit absentee ballots to be hand-delivered/dropped off at school districts through 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, June 9, or received by mail through June 16.

Qualified voters in the Port Washington School District can drop off their completed absentee ballots at the District's administration offices located at 100 Campus Drive, Port Washington, New York, 11050. Hours for drop-off are today, Monday, June 8, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., and tomorrow, Tuesday, June 9, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

As provided for in the Governor's executive order, mailed ballots will be accepted by the District through Tuesday, June 16.
